## GO MAKE DISCIPLES—LENT—PRAYER

The season of Lent has arrived!

This week we will continue with the discussion of the three traditional pillars of Lent. As a reminder, these three pillars are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. This week, we will be looking deeper at prayer in relation to Lent.



Prayer is an essential component in growing closer to God. It is a way for us to connect to God and to remind us of His sacrifice for us on the cross especially during the Lent season. By praying, we not only grow deeper in our faith, but we find comfort and hope knowing God is always there to listen to us and help us. It is important to remember that prayer is not just for us to be the ones talking, but it should also be a time when we are listening to what God wants to tell us. The more often we spend in prayer, the easier it is for us to hear God's voice. If you are someone who is new to praying or wishing to pray more, start small and work your way up. Try to set aside at least 15 minutes a day for prayer and watch yourself grow into a deeper Faith! No matter where you are in your prayer life, Lent is the perfect time to seek a deeper prayer life and grow closer to God.

At Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament, we are blessed to have so many beautiful options for prayer throughout the year. For example, you could spend time at adoration, pray the Rosary before Mass, attend the Stations of the Cross, or sign up to be an adorer at the Perpetual Adoration Chapel at St. Mary Church in Fennimore. What is great about the pillar of prayer is that it can be fulfilled through these great opportunities like the ones listed above and it can also be fulfilled from your home, your car, or really anywhere. You can incorporate prayer within your own home by reading the daily readings, spending time in silence, or completing an examination of conscience each day. Prayer is wonderful in the way that you don't have to do it alone. Invite your family or friends to pray with you. Set aside time each night to pray as a family or to learn a new prayer together. Prayer is so powerful!

Next week we will discuss the second pillar of Lent, which is fasting. Let us pray for a blessed Lenten season for ourselves and for all of those around us.
