

GO MAKE DISCIPLES NEWS CORNER

No Man Is An Island.

The one overriding fact of life I've experienced running a hobby farm is that true self-sufficiency is a myth. As much as you may try, about as close as you can get is to re-



duce dependency on the grocery store. However, there is an innate drive in all of us to be self-reliant. I suppose in a way it's a sign of reaching adulthood, "I can make it on my own." In the same way, we can easily "go solo" with our spiritual life. However, it is easy to become discouraged as we "go it alone" in the secular society.

In his letter Spe Salvi, Pope Benedict points out:

Our lives are involved with one another, through innumerable interactions they are linked together. No one lives alone. No one sins alone. No one is saved alone. The lives of others continually spill over into mine: in what I think, say, do and achieve. And conversely, my life spills over into that of others: for better and for worse (Spe Salvi, 48)

This was the lesson learned "the hard way" by Jimmy Stewart's character George Bailey in the movie *It's a Wonderful Life*.

It's important as Catholics to acknowledge we are not alone, but are linked spiritually with God and each other through our faith and baptism. A way to connect with our fellow Catholics is through events sponsored by the diocese. One such happening for men is the Men of Christ Conference at Waunakee's St. John the Baptist Parish on September 21st. Its purpose is to

...evangelize, catechize, and unify Catholic men by bringing in speakers who will motivate, educate, and push each participant to improve themselves. The experience of attending these conferences with other similarly situated Catholic men will form a brotherhood that will empower each man boldly to live his Catholic faith (Men of Christ Charter).

The upcoming Men of Christ conference is titled "Called to Save The World," featuring Father Chris Alar whose topic is "Living the Fatima Message In Your Vocation." 
