GO MAKE DISCIPLES—CARLOS ACUTIS, SOON TO BE A SAINT

On Divine Mercy Sunday, April 27, Blessed Carlos Acutis, the first millennial to be beatified by the Catholic Church, will be canonized in St. Peter’s Square during the Jubilee of Teenagers. He will be the patron saint of youth, computer programmers, and influencers.



This British-born Italian website designer, who documented Eucharistic miracles and approved Marian apparitions (appearances of Mary) on his website before his death of leukemia at age 15, was noted for his cheerfulness, computer skills, and devotion to the Eucharist, which became a core theme of his life. On his first communion, he said to his mother (who is still alive), “To always be close to Jesus, that’s my life plan.” To accomplish this, young Acutis sought to attend daily Mass as often as he could at his parish church across the street from his elementary school in Milan. Carlos loved the Eucharist, “my highway to heaven,” and did all in his power to make this Presence known. His witness inspired his own parents to return fully to practicing the Catholic faith and his Hindu au pair (Governess) to convert and be baptized.

Carlos was a tech-savvy kid who was convinced that the evidence of Eucharistic miracles could be persuasive in helping people to realize that Jesus is present at every Mass. Over the course of 2-1/2 years, the young man worked with his family to put together an exhibit on Eucharistic miracles that premiered in 2005 during the Year of the Eucharist proclaimed by Pope John Paul II and has gone on display at thousands of parishes on five continents! I saw it at St. Clements Church in Lancaster, WI. Did you? Sadly, young Acutis died on October 12, 2006, shortly after being diagnosed with a virulent form of leukemia. He is buried in Assisi, a favorite place of his. His body is displayed there, incorrupt.

Many of Carlos’ classmates, friends, and family members testified to how he brought them closer to God. As a very open person he wasn’t shy about speaking to anyone he met about the things he loved – the Mass, the Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, and Heaven. He is remembered for saying, “People who put themselves before the sun get a tan; people who place themselves before the Eucharist become saints.”

Won’t you join Jesus today? He is adored 24 -7 – 365 at the Eucharistic Chapel in Fennimore!
